



## Musculoskeletal Management Program Provider Education Webinars

In keeping with our commitment of promoting continuous quality improvement, Wellcare will be expanding its partnership with National Imaging Associates Inc. (NIA)\* to implement a Musculoskeletal (MSK) Management Program effective Feb. 1, 2024.
